### CONTEST GUIDELINES AND PARTICIPANTS

#### A. SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST

- 1. It must be in the English Language using a maximum of ten (10) words.
- 2. Use A4-size bond paper and any traditional materials (colored pencils/pens, crayons, pastel, etc.)
- 3. The slogan will be judged according to the following criteria:
  - 3.1 Relevance to the theme 30%
  - 3.2 Originality 30%
  - 3.3 Creativity 25%
  - 3.4 Impact and Presentation 15%

#### **B. POSTER MAKING CONTEST**

- 1. The poster must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme, "Mathematics for Everyone".
- 2. The posters shall have the following specifications:
  - 2.1 The size of the poster must be 1/8 of an illustration board (10" x 15") and in the portrait format.
  - 2.2 Bear the text elements "Mathematics for everyone".
- 3. The poster will be judged according to the following criteria:
  - 3.1 Relevance to the theme 40%
  - 3.2 Originality 30%
  - 3.3 Creativity and Presentation 15%

4. The posters are governed by the laws and regulations concerning intellectual property. Thus, participants are strictly advised to submit original work and avoid using elements on the poster which could expose it to copyright infringement.

## C. MATHEMATICIAN LOOK-ALIKE CONTEST

- 1. The uploaded entry must in PPT format with the ff. slides:
  - 1.1 First slide contains the name, grade, section and the original appearance of the participant.
  - 1.2 Second slide contains the participant (dressed up) and the mathematician. Include the important contributions of the mathematician.
- 2. This will be judged according to the following criteria:
  - 2.1 Likeness 50%
  - 2.2 Creativity 25%
  - 2.3 Presentation and Impact <u>– 25%</u>
